

DIRECTIONS TO KAPOHO BEACH LOTS

From Kona Airport

1. Take Highway 19 north (a left turn out of the airport).
2. Follow Highway 19 through Waimea/Kamuela to Hilo. (The northern route through Waimea/Kamuela down to Hilo is about 1 hour shorter than the southern route around South Point.)
3. After passing the Hilo bay front, turn right onto Highway 11 (Ken's House of Pancakes is on the corner).
4. Pass the Hilo airport (you'll be heading south on Highway 11), and follow remaining directions below.



From Hilo Airport

1. Take Hwy 11 south (a left turn out of the airport)
2. Drive for about 6 miles.
3. Turn left at Keaau onto Highway 130.
4. Continue for about 11.5 miles and turn left at the traffic light onto Highway 132.
5. Follow signs to Kapoho (about 8 miles). CAUTION: Be sure to bear left after the Lava Tree State Park. If you don't, you'll depart from Highway 132.
6. Turn right on Hwy 137 (if you hit a dirt road you went too far).
7. Turn left at first road (about 3/10 mile or 1 minute's drive). It is called Kapoho Beach Lots road but there is not a sign on it.
8. Follow this road for about 3/4 mile. Just before the security gate is a group of mail boxes on the left, similar to post office boxes. The boxes are organized into groups of 2 columns. The first group is on the left as you face the boxes.
9. Locate mail box number 3867. It is in the first group of boxes, second column, 4th box down. In addition to 3867, it also has a 12 on it. Note that each group of boxes has a box 12 but 3867 is a unique number. Jiggle the key a little as you insert it to open the protective cover. There will be a packet inside the mail box with your name on it. Inside the packet will be directions, a key to the house and a gate remote (like a garage door opener).



Notes & Recommendations

- * If you are flying in to Hilo, sit on the airplane's right hand side (as you look towards the front). As you approach the Big Island you will usually see the observatories on top of 14,000 ft Mauna Kea (snow capped in winter), forests and farmland at the lower elevations and then waterfalls tumbling over the cliffs into the ocean. It is very beautiful.
- * Please bring a flashlight with you to make it easier to locate and open the mail box. If you have a problem, there is a phone mounted on the bulletin board just inside the gate. Calls are limited to 1 minute local calls.
- * We highly recommend that you pick up some groceries in Hilo at either the KTA or Sak N Save supermarket before checking in. They are located in the shopping center on the right hand side of Hwy 11 a little over a mile past the Hilo airport. There is also a nice natural foods market in Pahoa if you prefer.
